# Principal's Report:

- 21C learning (virtual manipulatives) Mathies Learning Tools The group had a look at the different resources available on the website and explored the different virtual manipulatives. Teachers can use this tool in the classroom in many different ways, for example taking screen shots and displaying it on the smart board as a way to share or discuss the work with the rest of the class.
- New IPads / Chromebooks: We are now up to 3 carts School received a new set of Chrome books and Ipads.
- Application for Speak Up (Be Healthy, Be Happy, Be Me) –
- What's happening at Lansdowne:
  - o *Kindergarten Open House*: Happening this Thursday at 5:30.
